Project Team Updates:

Toscano's PEX Team is in the completion stages of the following jobs: the WTC BPS Project, Brooklyn Bridge Park, Battery Park Police Memorial, Lincoln Tunnel, and Holland Tunnel. They are in the beginning stages of Coler Hospital Fire Pump Relocation, Roy Wilkins Recreation Center, and Louis Armstrong Museum. The team will be working on a new transit project; Shoreline Upgrades at Kingsbridge Bus Depot.

Vulcano's PEX Team completed 7 of 11 ferry landings on the Upland Ferry Terminal project for Skanska. At Lehman College, the roofing replacement is wrapping up on schedule and structural steel is currently underway and scheduled to finish in November as the project team moves forward to start the metal panel system installation.
